At the A1 level the learner will be asked to write a minimum of two sentences for Task 1, a minimum of five sentences for Task 2. Task 3 will require a minimum of ten sentences. Task 4 is a Gap filling exercise.

Sentences should be descriptive and use adjectives, as well as adverbs of place and time where relevant. Learners are allowed to use English only or picture dictionaries; no bilingual dictionaries are permitted. Time allowed is 1 hour.
