Play the sentences.

Part 2 – Conversations

You will hear two conversations. Read the questions and answers on your examination paper for both conversations. You have two minutes to read them.

Pause for two minutes.

Listen to **Conversation 1.** You will hear the conversation twice. Answer the questions.

You will then have two minutes to check your answers.

Play the conversation.

Receptionist: Hello, Mario's Pizza. Can I help you? **Customer**: Yes. I am calling to book a table, please.

Receptionist: When do you want to book for?

Customer: Tomorrow night, please. **Receptionist**: For how many people?

Customer: Five. Three adults and two children. **Receptionist**: OK. What time would you like to come?

Customer: At 8 o'clock please.

Receptionist: I am sorry, we do not have any tables for 5 at 8 o'clock. Could you come at 8:30 instead?

Customer: Yes, that is fine. Do you have a children's menu? **Receptionist**: Yes, we do. We have smaller pizzas for children.

Customer: That is great.

Receptionist: OK. What is your name? **Customer**: My name is Jo Harris.

Pause for ten seconds after the first reading.

Now listen to the conversation again.

Play the conversation again.

Now check your answers. You have two minutes to check your answers.



Part 2 – Conversations

Listen to **Conversation 2**. You will hear the conversation twice. Answer the questions.

You will then have two minutes to check your answers.

Play the conversation

Customer: Hello. Can I get two coffees, please?

Shop assistant: Yes, no problem. Is that two large coffees?

Customer: No, small coffees please.

Shop assistant:: That is fine. Would you like something to eat? **Customer:** Yes, please. Which sandwiches do you have today?

Shop assistant:: We have cheese, chicken, or egg.

Customer: I will have two egg sandwiches, please.

Shop assistant:: Ok, I will make those for you now.

Customer: How much will that be?

Shop assistant:: For your coffee and sandwiches, the total is £14.20. Would you like to pay by cash or

card?

Customer: Card, please.

Shop assistant:: Thank you. Just place your card here.

Pause for ten seconds after the first reading.

Now listen to the conversation again.

Play the conversation again.

Now check your answers. You have two minutes to check your answers.



Part 3 – Broadcasts

You will hear two broadcasts. Read the questions and answers on your examination paper for both broadcasts. You have two minutes to read them.

Pause for two minutes.

Listen to **Broadcast 1.** You will hear the broadcast twice. Answer the questions.

You will then have two minutes to check your answers.

Play the broadcast.

Furry Friends is a charity that looks after animals. We need more people to come and help our charity.

The charity is on the north side of the town, just past the supermarket.

If you would like to help, then come to meet the lovely dogs and cats. They are all friendly and love people. You can help with feeding, walking and cleaning the animals.

Part 3 – Broadcasts

Listen to **Broadcast 2**. You will hear the broadcast twice. Answer the questions.

You will then have two minutes to check your answers.

Play the broadcast.

Good morning. Here is the weather forecast for today.

In London, it is bright and sunny all day. The temperature is twenty-eight degrees. Make sure you wear sunscreen. Wear a hat if you are out in the sun. Drink lots of water. Stay out of the sun in the afternoon.

In Manchester, it is cooler. The temperature is eighteen degrees. There is a light wind. Wear a jacket to keep warm.

In Cardiff, it is sunny. The temperature is twenty-six degrees. There is a chance of rain. Don't forget your umbrella. You might need a rain coat.

Pause for ten seconds after the first reading.

Now listen to the broadcast again.

Play the broadcast again.

Now check your answers. You have two minutes to check your answers.

Pause for two minutes after the second reading.
