At the A2 level the learner will be asked to write a minimum of two sentences for Task 1, a minimum of five sentences for Task 2. Task 3 will require a minimum of ten sentences. Task 4 is a Gap filling exercise.

Sentences should be descriptive using adjectives, and conjunctions, as well as adverbs of place and time where relevant. Learners are allowed to use English only or picture dictionaries; no bilingual dictionaries are permitted. Time allowed is 1 hour.
